**7<sup>TH</sup> INTERNATIONAL SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE  
GEOBALCANICA 2021**

**15-16 June 2021, Ohrid, North Macedonia**



On 15-16 June 2021, the 7<sup>th</sup> International Scientific Conference GEOBALCANICA 2021 was organised by Geobalcanica Society in mixed format, presentations with physical presence and presentations with online presence due to Coronavirus (COVID-19) context.

The contributions were grouped into four sections: Physical Geography, Socio-Economic Geography, Cartography, GIS & Spatial Planning, Teaching and Education in Geography.

There were presented 13 papers and 5 poster presentations with physical presence and covered all four sections. Regarding the presentations with online presence the distribution was as follows. The total number of oral presentations was 52: 24 in Physical Geography, 14 in Socio-Economic Geography, 10 in Cartography, GIS & Spatial Planning and 4 in Teaching and Education in Geography. The posters presented were 29 in total: 21 in Socio-Economic Geography, 5 in Teaching and Education in Geography, 2 in Cartography, GIS & Spatial Planning and 1 in Physical Geography.

The papers and posters covered various topics from different perspectives and geographical areas and were connected to the latest researches in the field.

The scientific event involved the participation of an important number of researches coming from 13 countries: North Macedonia, Poland, Romania, Serbia, Austria, Bulgaria, Slovenia, Russia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, France, Turkey, Cameroon and Croatia.

Romania was represented by participants coming from: University of Bucharest, Institute of Geography, Romanian Academy, "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University of Iași, West University of Timișoara, Ștefan cel Mare University of Suceava and "Vasile Alecsandri" University of Bacău.
